Categories of Cookies Used by CrediBar

Category	Description
Essential Cookies (Mandatory)	These cookies are necessary for secure login, form submissions, and fraud detection. They cannot be disabled, as they are crucial for the functioning of the website.
Customization and Analytics Cookies	These cookies track interactions, such as clicks, and help us analyze which pages are most popular. This data allows us to tailor content and improve the website. The information is aggregated and anonymous. If disabled, we cannot optimize your experience.
Personalized Offer Cookies	Set by our advertising partners, these cookies track pages and links you visit to show relevant ads and offers. No personal information is captured. If disabled, you will see generic ads, which may not match your interests.
Performance and Functionality Cookies	These cookies are set by us or our partners to enable smooth functionality of services on the website. If disabled, certain features may not work properly.

Managing Your Cookie Preferences

You have the option to restrict or block cookies on our website at any time by adjusting your browser settings. We record your consent when you accept our use of cookies and periodically ask for consent to ensure you stay informed about any updates to our cookie practices.

Essential cookies cannot be disabled.

How to Block Cookies

You can choose whether to accept cookies or not. If you decline cookies, some features on the CrediBar website may not function properly. You can manage cookies by:
